ORDERED: That this City Council go on record opposing House Bill # 5378, "An Act to Eliminate unnecessary Government Regulation of Professionals," which would eliminate the Board of Registration of Cosmetologists, Electrologists and Barbers and the licensing requirements for Cosmetologists, Estheticians, Manicurists, Barbers and Electrologists.

On July 24, 1995, Governor Weld filed for consideration by the House of Representatives and the Senate, a reorganization plan known as, House Bill #5348, "An Act to Eliminate Unnecessary Government Regulation of Professionals." Included in this bill is the elimination of the Board of Registration of Cosmetologists, Electrologists, and Barbers, and the licensing requirements for Cosmetologists, Estheticians, Manicurists, Barbers, and Electrologists.

- **PRIVILEGE** of getting another state's license without going back to school

WITHOUT YOUR LICENSE

- **PRIVILEGE DENIED!** Malpractice insurance will not be sold in MA. Underwriters will only service licensed professionals, or the equivalent, thereof, for risk reasons
- **PRIVILEGE DENIED!** "For professional use only by licensed cosmetologists" products will not be sold in MA because their product liability insurance is only valid when used or sold by licensed professionals
- **PRIVILEGE DENIED!** Only available to licensed professionals
- **PRIVILEGE DENIED!** No reciprocity with any other state without a license
- **SECURITY DENIED!** Anyone, a skilled or unskilled person, can open a salon next to you and unfairly compete
- **Loss of income and salon closings**

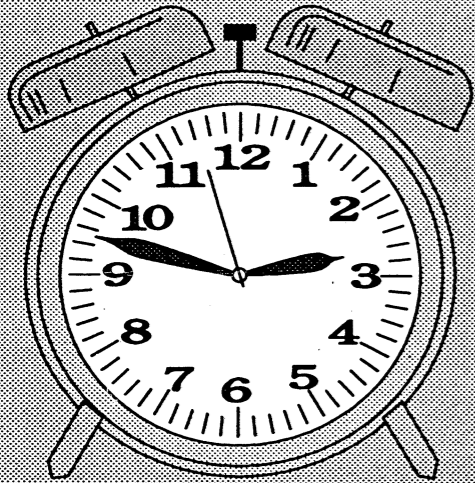

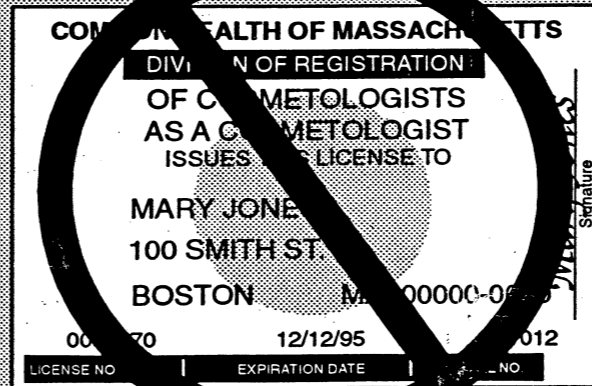
