WHEREAS: Eva J. Paddock was appointed principal of the Agassiz School in January, 1992 and served as its educational leader until her retirement in September of 1996; and

WHEREAS: Eva Paddock has throughout her life in the field of education, exemplified the highest ideals of the American educator and contributed immeasurably to the growth, character, and intellectual capacity of scores of children who have been the privileged recipients of her knowledge, kindness and understanding; and

WHEREAS: In tribute to her long and distinguished career in education, a testimonial will be held on November 12, 1996 at Oakley Country Club in Belmont to express the admiration and affection of colleagues, students, and citizens of Cambridge; now therefore be it
