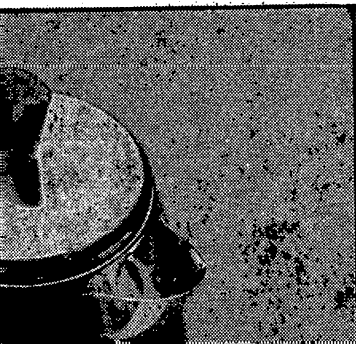


3d city votes to be refugee sanctuary

CAMBRIDGE, Mass.—The Cambridge City Council voted 5-4 Monday night to make the city an official sanctuary for Latin American refugees to protest the Reagan administration's crackdown on illegal aliens. The resolution establishes Cambridge as an official sanctuary for refugees and directs municipal workers not to cooperate with federal investigators searching for an estimated 5,000 illegal aliens living in the city, which is home to Harvard University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Berkeley, Calif., and St. Paul have approved similar resolutions.
