- WHEREAS:** The City's mandatory recycling program has been delayed due to problems with the existing landfill and the state's slow action taking the land and cleaning up the landfill; and,
- WHEREAS:** The City Manager's report dated January 9, 1989 indicates the City will be instituting an interim recycling program but is vague on the details of its implementation; and,
- WHEREAS:** Thoughtful public policy concerning recycling protects the environment, saves energy and creates jobs; and
- WHEREAS:** Cambridge residents and businesses have for years asked the City for a workable recycling program; and,
- WHEREAS:** The City Council in numerous recorded votes has asked the City Manager to institute a recycling program; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to give his immediate and sustained attention to finalizing the details about both the permanent and temporary recycling programs; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager report his progress on these matters to the City Council on a regular basis.
