D. Cameron Forbes, 59

Former WGBH lighting designer

D. Cameron Forbes of Cambridge, a former lighting designer for WGBH, died Tuesday at his daughter's Cambridge home of pancreatic cancer. He was 59.

Mr. Forbes was born in Boston. He was raised in Sudbury and graduated from Harvard University in 1961.

He was a lighting designer at WGBH in Boston, where he met his future wife. He also was lighting director and official photographer for The Theatre Company of Boston. One of his more memorable photos was of actor Al Pacino, which later appeared in Time magazine.

He leaves his mother, Faith Fisher Forbes; his former wife, Peggy Woodford; two daughters, Maya and China; a brother, Richard; and two sisters, Dinny and Wendy.

A funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday in St. Elizabeth's Chapel, Sudbury.
