WHEREAS: From time to time, homeowners have maintenance or rehabilitation work done on their house requiring workers to park nearby; and

WHEREAS: There are continued complaints about the ticketing of such vehicles and no alternatives for parking; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Director of Traffic and Parking to issue parking permits for the use of residents for the time they are having work done on their houses; and be it further

ORDERED: That the method of obtaining the limited-time permits be as simple and unbureaucratic as possible.
