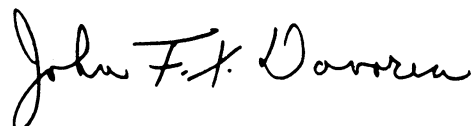

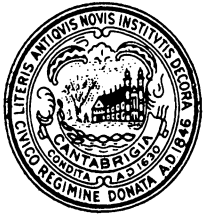
TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER ALL KINDS OF EDUCATIONAL, REHABILITATIVE, ADVISORY, AND OTHER TYPES OF ACTIVITIES THAT PERTAIN TO PERSONAL SERVICES FOR THE BENEFIT OF ANY PERSON OR PERSONS OR CORPORATIONS WITH FULL POWER TO ACQUIRE, HOLD, MANAGE, AND DISPOSE OF ANY AND ALL KINDS OF PROPERTY OF WHATSOEVER KIND OR NATURE, AND TO TRANSACT ALL BUSINESS AND DO ANY AND ALL ACTS AND THINGS WHATSOEVER NECESSARY, PROPER, CONVENIENT, DESIRABLE OR INCIDENTAL TO THE CARRYING OUT OF THE BUSINESS ABOVE MENTIONED.

TO DO ALL AND EVERYTHING NECESSARY, SUITABLE, AND PROPER FOR THE ACCOMPLISHMENT OF ANY OF THE PURPOSES, OR THE ATTAINMENT OF ANY OF THE OBJECTS, OR THE FURTHERANCE OF ANY OF THE POWERS HEREINBEFORE SET FORTH, EITHER ALONE OR IN ASSOCIATION WITH OTHER CORPORATIONS, FIRMS, OR INDIVIDUALS, AND TO DO EVERY OTHER ACT OR ACTS, THING OR THINGS, INCIDENTAL OR APPURTENANT

NOTE: If provisions for which the space provided under Articles 2, 3 and 4 is not sufficient, additions should be set out on continuation sheets to be numbered 2A, 2B, etc. Indicate under each Article where the provision is set out. 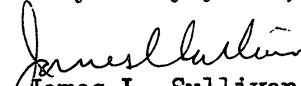
