

Cambridge, Oct. 27 1884.

To the Honorable, the Mayor, and Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge,

The undersigned respectfully ~~pray~~ represent, that at a considerable expense, they caused to be prepared for public travel, the unaccepted way leading from Halden street, westerly, and known as Crescent Avenue. Said avenue has heretofore been used by your petitioners as a convenient means of approach to North Avenue. During the past year, a strip of land twenty feet in width was taken by the city in said Crescent Avenue, and a common sewer laid therein. In the construction of this sewer the roadway was dug over, and when the same was levelled, after the completion of said sewer, a large portion of the gravel taken from the surface, having been thrown to the bottom, a mixture of gravel, clay and other unfit material was placed on the top of the ground, such as is utterly unfit for a road. The present condition of the avenue is such, that the freezing and thawing of the coming season will render it impassible to heavy teams, to the great inconvenience and damage of your petitioners. before the construction of the aforesaid sewer.
