POTABLE CELLULAR COMMUNICATIONS, INC./PTC CELLULAR, INC.

Portable Cellular Communications, Inc. ("PCC"), a New York Corporation which provides cellular telecommunications services in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and PTC Cellular, Inc. ("PTC"), a Delaware corporation, have filed a joint application requesting approval by the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") for the transfer of the certificate of public convenience and necessity ("Certificate") held by PCC including all assets and subscribers, and the ownership and control of PCC to PTC.

Pursuant to an asset purchase agreement among Peoples Telephone Company, Inc., a New York corporation, PTC, PCC and Nationwide Cellular Service, Inc., a Delaware corporation, PCC would purchase certain property and assets of PCC subject to the consent of the Department after the transfer of the control. Once the purchase is complete, customers formerly served by PCC would receive cellular telephone service from PTC.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

"Joint application of Potable Cellular Communications, Inc., and PTC Cellular, Inc., for approval of transfer of the Radio Common Carrier Facilities and Certificate of Potable Cellular Communications, Inc."

Comments, objections, and requests for a public hearing on the proposed transfer of control must be made in writing and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before June 28, 1993.

The petitioners, PPC and PTC, are required to give notice by publication hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [July 6, 1993], on the attached Radio Common Carrier ("RCC")/Cellular list, and to make return of service and publication no later than July 12, 1993.
