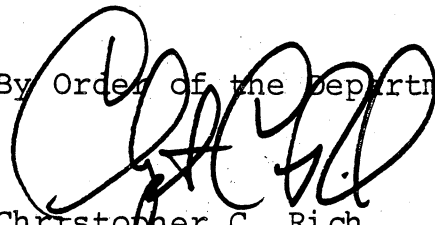

Nos., 111, Terms and Conditions; 112, Territory Served; 113, General Service; 114, Domestic; 115, Domestic Heating; 116, Large General; 117, Prime Mover; 118, Outdoor Lighting (Closed); 119, Air Conditioning; 120, Master-Meter (Closed); 121, Interruptible Service; 122, Cost of Gas Adjustment Clause; 123, Residential Conservation Service Charge; and 99, Cancellation Supplement to Liquefaction Rate, filed with the Department on May 17, 1982 to become effective June 1, 1982 by the Commonwealth Gas Company.
