WHEREAS: Residents of North Cambridge are very concerned about people crossing the tracks which are heavily use; now therefore be it

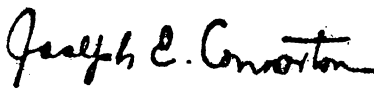
