Dear Mr. Healy,

Thank you for forwarding the Constable appointment forms for the twelve security supervisors we hope to have sworn in soon. Regarding your inquiry to a question brought up at the council meeting as to why there are not more Cambridge residents on the list, we do have 5 full time guards on the roster, having only 2-3 years experience, and none in the supervisor capacity. The supervisors average 13 years in experience, and 6 are in the 15 to 25 year range, all of whom have been City of Cambridge Constables throughout their years on the Security Force.

Our intention is to have supervisors on each shift available to detain or make arrests on the property if necessary, due to the numerous amount of demonstrations we have been experiencing. With the spontaneous and capable aid of the Cambridge Police Department, 64 arrest have been made on the property since December, 1979.

The Laboratory is currently undergoing a recruitment drive to hire qualified guard personnel from Cambridge, two being hired in 1981 and another is due to start, having recently passed interview and reference checks.

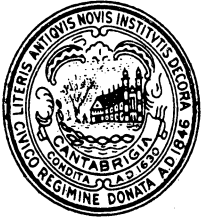


