Pedestrian lights across Huron Avenue at the Fresh Pond Golf Course.

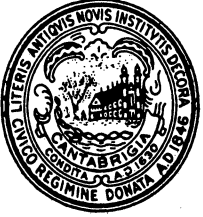

The delay in completing this study is due to the area considered being at the foot of a steep grade and also at a bad turn in the road which is the worst place to install signals.

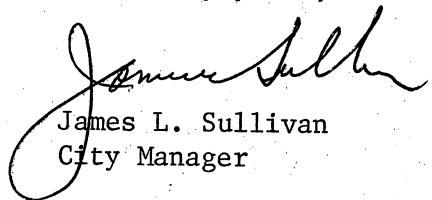
