An Ordinance

Establishing the Salary of the Mayor of the City.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sect. 1. So much of the Ordinance establishing the Salaries of Sundry City Officers, adopted December 24<sup>th</sup>. in the year One Thousand Eight-Hundred and Fifty-six, as relates to the Salary of the Mayor, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2.— From and after the first Monday in January in the year One Thousand Eight-Hundred and Fifty-eight, the Salary of the Mayor of the City shall be Fifteen Hundred Dollars annually, payable in equal quarterly payments; which shall be in full for all services rendered by him in his official capacity.—
