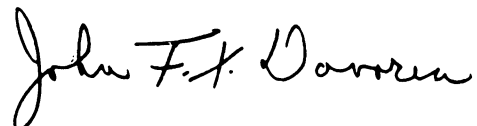

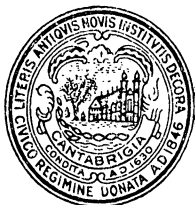

Pursuant to a communication from the Secretary of State re: "Polish Scouting Organization in U.S.A., Inc.," I made an investigation.

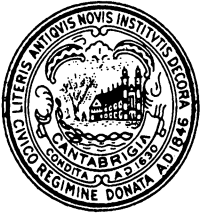
