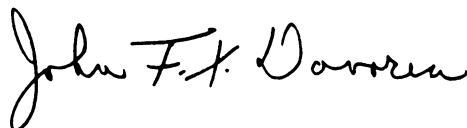

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The educational purpose of the University Network Corp. will be to use audio-visual media to further the education of students, professionals, and the general public.

University Network Corp. will endeavor to coordinate both individual and institutional members of the academic community in the production and distribution of high quality documentary films and educational film shorts based exclusively on writings and research originating within the university community.

University Network Corp. will act to facilitate arrangements for financing these films by encouraging colleges, universities, and educational-oriented organizations to cooperatively pool financial, administrative, and learning resources.

The corporation will engage in any other activity in the furtherance of its purpose(s) permitted to it by Chapter 180 of the Massachusetts General Laws, and further permitted by Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as it may now exist and may hereafter be amended.

NOTE: If provisions for which the space provided under Articles 2, 3 and 4 is not sufficient, additions should be set out on continuation sheets to be numbered 2A, 2B, etc. Indicate under each Article where the provision is set out. Continuation sheets shall be on 8½" x 11" paper and must have a left-hand margin 1 inch wide for binding. Only one side should be used.

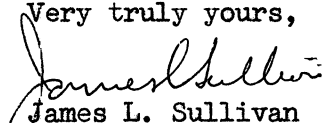
