COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

- WHEREAS: Cambridge is suffering from an anxiety-tension epidemic which afflicts the entire nation and from which everyone suffers; and
- WHEREAS: The Unidentified Flying Idea is devoted to teaching simple and safe procedures for the relief of anxiety-tension and has offered this instruction free of charge to the community of Cambridge for the past three years; and
- WHEREAS: The Unidentified Flying Idea believes that these procedures should be made available to city employees and that their practice will improve the efficiency and responsiveness of city government; and
- WHEREAS: The Unidentified Flying Idea finds itself at present without a storefront or facility to work out of; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Unidentified Flying Idea be allowed to use available space in the Cambridge City Hall to teach "first-aid" massage to city workers on their lunch-hours (noon to 2 p.m.), twice weekly (Tuesday and Thursday) for a one month trial period.
