WHEREAS: By Act of Congress of the United States dated June 14, 1777, the first official Flag of the United States was adopted; and

WHEREAS: By Act of Congress dated August 3, 1949, June 14 of each year was designated "NATIONAL FLAG DAY"; and

WHEREAS: The Congress has requested the President to issue annually a resolution designating the week in which June 14 occurs as "NATIONAL FLAG WEEK" and

WHEREAS: On December 8, 1982, the National Flag Day Foundation was charged to conduct educational programs and to encourage all Americans to PAUSE FOR THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE as part of the celebration of National Flag Day throughout the nation; and

WHEREAS: By Act of Congress, dated June 20, 1985, Public Law 99-54 was passed to have the PAUSE FOR THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE as part of the celebration of National Flag Day throughout the nation; and

WHEREAS: Flag Day celebrates our nation's symbol of unity, a democracy in a republic, and stands for our country's devotion to freedom, to the rule of all, and to equal rights for all; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council proclaim Thursday, June 14, 2001 as Flag Day in Cambridge and urge all citizens of Cambridge to pause at 7:00 PM EDT on this date for the 22nd annual National PAUSE FOR THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG and join all Americans in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to The National Flag Day Foundation, Inc. on behalf of the entire City Council.
