We knew of no hearing to be held on February 7, and feel that we should have been advised of such a meeting.

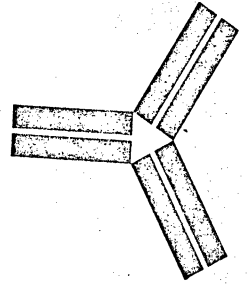

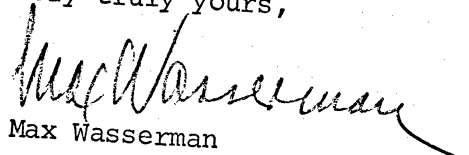
