ORDERED: That the second meeting of the month be first dedicated to public hearings and thereafter general business and that Rule 23 of the City Council be amended to so state; and be it further

ORDERED: That the Municipal Code of Cambridge Chapter 2.26, Section 2.62.020, Subsection F1a be amended by striking Thirty-one Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and inserting the words Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars and that Subsection F1b be amended by striking Ten Thousand Dollars and inserting Five Thousand Dollars and Subsection F1c by striking Thirty-one Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and inserting Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars. The funds saved by this cut in salaries be used to pay for two secretaries and two researchers to be employed on a full-time basis to assist members of the Council with research and constituent services. This section shall become effective July 1, 1993.
