- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that on Thursday, September 15, 1983, the Fire Department was called to the Manning Apartments located at the corner of Pearl Street and Franklin Street, under the jurisdiction of the Cambridge Housing Authority; and
- WHEREAS: The Fire Department made repeated attempts to contact someone at the Housing Authority regarding the alarm system, but the Fire Alarm operator, after making several calls to a particular number, was placed on "hold" and no one returned to the phone; and
- WHEREAS: Although this particular time no immediate emergency existed, the potential of such was present and the elderly of this City must always be protected; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Executive Director of the Housing Authority in order to determine what, if any, emergency notification system is in place whereby the Police and Fire Departments can readily contact the Authority in the event of an emergency; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide this City Council with the kind of notification process established by the Housing Authority within two weeks.
