WHEREAS: On September 30, 2004 the Cambridge YWCA will hold its 17th Annual Tribute to Outstanding Women; and

WHEREAS: At this gala luncheon, the YWCA will celebrate the achievements of ten outstanding women; and

WHEREAS: Lindsay Hyde, founder and director of Strong Women, Strong Girls, a public service mentoring program, will receive a 2004 YWCA Outstanding Woman Award; and

WHEREAS: Lindsay developed her program while still in her high school. The aim of the program is to give girls strong female role models. During the school year, thirty Harvard women work with 200 at-risk girls in seven Boston after-school programs. Last February Lindsay started up her program with YWCA 3rd-5th graders; and

WHEREAS: In Strong Women, Strong Girls, girls learn about prominent women and explore activities that promote healthy self-esteem. These include goal setting, communicating ideas, developing cultural sensitivity and mediating differences instead of fighting; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record congratulating Lindsay Hyde on being recognized by the Cambridge YWCA as a 2004 Outstanding Woman; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lindsay Hyde on behalf of the entire City Council.
