BOSTON EDISON COMPANY

Boston Edison Company has filed proposed Interruptible Rates - Conservation and Load Management proposal in response to the Department of Public Utilities' Order in D.P.U. 84-194. The filing consists of two parts:

- Two interruptible rate tariffs, based on marginal cost, for service in various voltage levels. The tariffs bear a proposed effective date of January 1, 1986
- A proposal for six conservation and load management pilot programs, and documentation of the cost benefit model used to evaluate the programs.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in the following schedules: M.D.P.U. Nos. 710, Experimental Customer Interruptible Rate SC-1; 711, Experimental Interruptible Rate SC-2; filed with the Department on December 2, 1985 to become effective January 1, 1986, by the Boston Edison Company.

The Department will conduct a public hearing regarding this matter on Tuesday, March 18, 1986 at 10:00 a.m. in its Hearing Room, No. 1210, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts.
