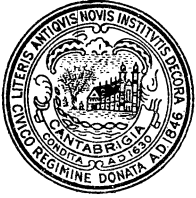

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$400 to reimburse Thomas A. Tosi, an employee of the Police Department for damages in this amount.

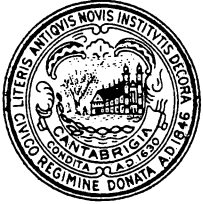
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Thomas A. Tosi in which there was a judgment of \$400.
