COUNCILLOR CRANE

- WHEREAS: This City Council Chamber is a public disgrace in its present condition with the ceiling leaking and the paint from the walls falling on the desks and floor, and
- WHEREAS: Previous Council orders regarding this condition have been submitted, adopted, and no action has been forthcoming from the administration, and
- WHEREAS: It is time that this City Council firmly established its concern over the lack of attention this important issue in receiving, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record strongly urging the City Manager to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to repair the roof of City Hall and to completely refurbish the Council Chamber, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That if said repairs do not commence within two weeks, that the press table be moved under the leak and the seat occupied by Councillor Crane be placed at the present location of the press table to draw public attention to the deplorable conditions under which this legislative body must deliberate, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is requested to forward samples of the paint chips from the ceiling and wall to the Hospital to be tested for lead content, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the City Manager without delay.
