RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council goes on record congratulating SEIU Local 615 organizers, security guards, and property owners and large tenants in Cambridge for bargaining fairly and in good faith to a positive result for all; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to SEIU 615 organizers on behalf of the entire City Council.
