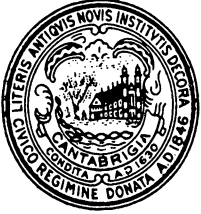
I do freelance typing at my home in Cambridge. My office skills could well be of use to the Commission.


To the Honorable, the City Council:
