An Ordinance
in aid of the Dana Library.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sec. 1. Whenever any moneys are received into
the City Treasury, under the provisions of chap-
ter 250 of the laws of 1879, the Treasurer shall
communicate to the Mayor, in writing, a state-
ment of the amount received, and the Mayor
shall lay the statement before the City Council;—
whereupon the City Council shall appropriate
such moneys in aid of the Dana Library, to
be applied by the Board of Trustees to the gene-

eral purposes of that institution.

Sec. 2. All appropriations made in pursu-
ance of the previous sections, shall be in addi-
tion to the amount annually appropriated
by the City for the use of the above named
Library.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect
upon the first day of January next.
