RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record requesting the City Manager to instruct the Superintendent of Recreation to withdraw his proposal and to continue the use of Lindstrom Field as a little league park, and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to post signs indicating that the field is restricted to little league use exclusively.

ZONING AMENDMENT HEARING NOTICE

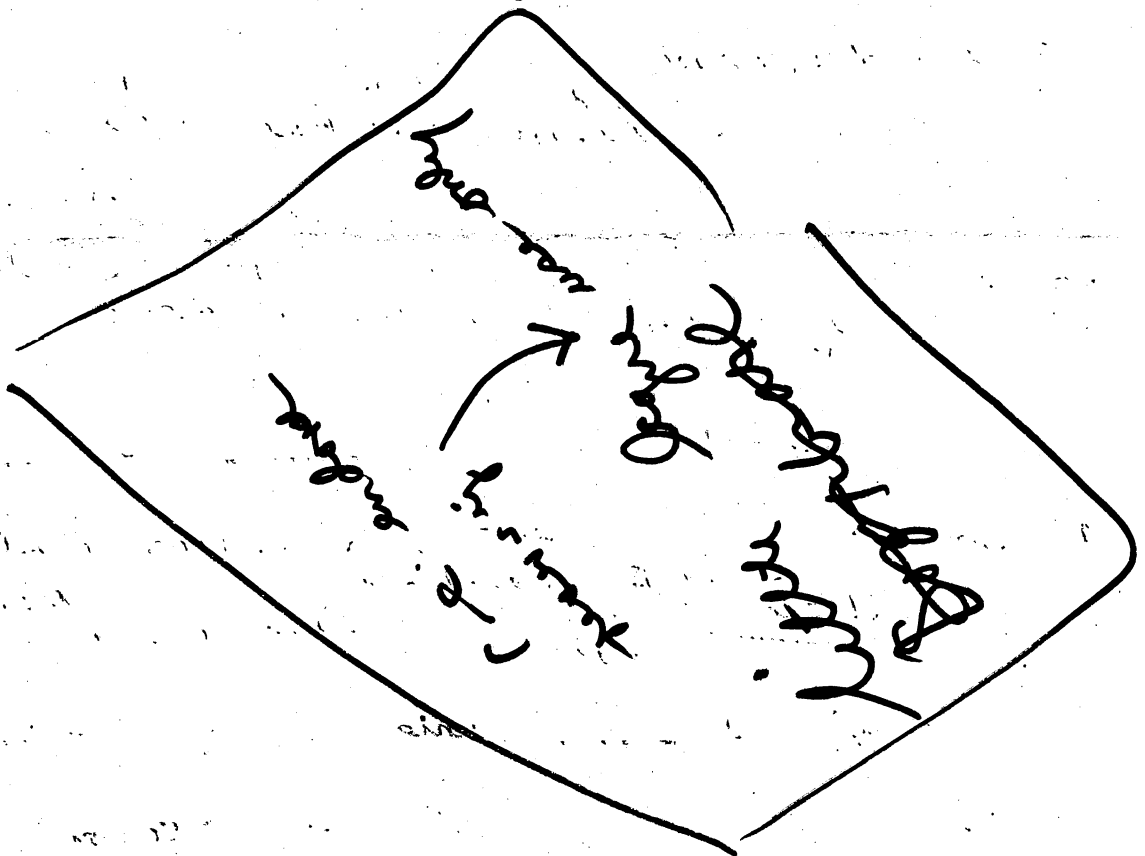
The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 20, 1976 at 8:00 P.M. in the City Council Chamber, City Hall, Cambridge, Mass. on a petition by City Councillor Francis Duehay to amend the text of the Zoning Ordinance as follows:

By adding an Article IX which would regulate the creation and maintenance of Community Residences and Personal Care Lodging Houses and prevent their intensive concentration in any one area of the City.

Further, the Article would define the terms Community Residence and Personal Care Lodging Houses and require a Special Permit for the establishment and maintenance of these facilities.

The public hearing is the first step in the process by which the Planning Board arrives at a recommendation on the proposed amendment. The Planning Board will submit its recommendation to the City Council which may then adopt or reject the amendment.

The Planning Board urges all interested citizens to attend this hearing and present their views.
