- WHEREAS: Ally supports through counseling, monitoring and caring vigilance the efforts of Carey participants to remain sober and to rebuild their lives after homelessness; and
- WHEREAS: Ally provides frank and honest assessments and insights, and on-site accessibility for program participants in the evening and weekend hours that can be especially difficult for those in early sobriety; and
- WHEREAS: Ally represents a role model of realistic success to the Carey participants; and
- WHEREAS: Ally's work promotes program harmony among diverse men living in a close-knit setting where consideration and respect for one's neighbors is extremely important; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation to Ally Fowler for his ongoing work with the men of the Carey Program, congratulate him on a job well done and offer best wishes for his continuing success in assisting men transitioning from homelessness; and be it further
