Ordered, Whereas the Proprietors of the Cambridge and Brookline Bridge propose to rebuild and repair said bridge, furnish a part of the money necessary to defray the expense thereof can be raised by subscription in Cambridge and Brookline, and whereas said bridge is of great convenience to many of the citizens of Cambridge who have occasion to go, on business or for pleasure, to Longwood and Brookline,

Ordered, That the Mayor be authorized to draw his order on the City Treasurer, in favor of the Treasurer of said Proprietors, for the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, the same to be charged to incidental Expenses.
