Clarke, the star of the new critically-acclaimed CBS sitcom, "Lenny," was the guest of honor at the massive party for nearly 700 invited guests.

The night's festivities were slated to include a roast by fellow Boston comics Kevin Knox and Don Gavin along with a city proclamation presented to Clarke by Mayor Flynn's stand-in, WBZ-TV sports anchor Bob Lobel.

Nearly 20 members of Clarke's family took in the event, along with a variety of the city's sports, comedy and media figures.

By 9 p.m., the Hard Rock Cafe already had turned into a packed, sweltering funhouse. Andre Tippet from the Patriots, Bruin Cam Neely and Lyndon Byers, fellow comics Jackie

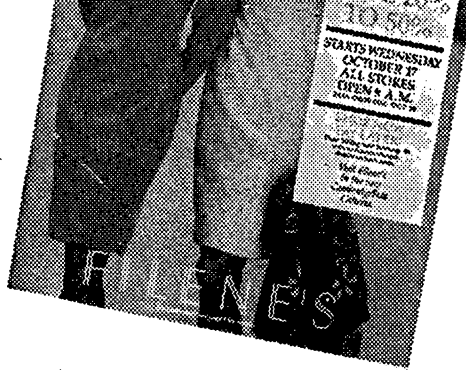
Flynn and Brian Kiley were among the guests at the invita-

Other early evening guests included WBZ entertainment reporter Joyce Kulhawik, WHDH-TV sportsman John Dennis and entertainment reporter Debbie Enblom, WBOS-FM general manager Mary Cashman, WXKS-FM and "Evening Magazine" reporter Billy Costa., WZLX-FM morning man Jeff Gonzer and afternoon jock Harvey Wharfield, and members of the local rock band The Fools.

"It's one of the most gratifying things that's ever happened in my life," Clarke gushed, "and I'm thankful and appreciative."

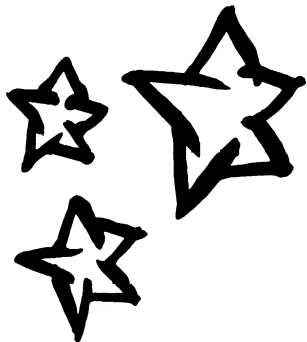

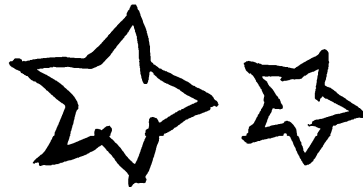
