To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$57,609.00 in the grant fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$2,743.00) and the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$54,866.00) from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development. This grant has been awarded to the Department of Human Service Programs for the second year in a row. The funding is used by the Department to provide housing search services to persons facing homelessness. This is a three year grant, the bulk of which will be subcontracted to the Greater Boston Housing Initiative for services to be provided at the Cambridge Multi-Service Center for the Homeless. Additional awards under this program are to be announced in early 1997.
