IN CITY COUNCIL

May 9, 1977

ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter 3, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Teresa Treacy, doing business as The Dutch Garden, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalk in front of the premises numbered 40 Brattle Street, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and providing further that before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.

Now comes the petitioner and states the following:

1. Petitioner does business as the Dutch Garden.
2. Petitioner sells cut flowers, floral arrangements and plants.
3. Petitioner rents 500 square feet and does business at 40 Brattle Street.
4. Petitioner's leasehold abuts in part, the sidewalk along Brattle Street.
5. The petitioner measured the sidewalk as having a width of ten feet and one-half foot of curbing where it abuts.

WHEREFORE the petitioner prays that this honorable Council grant a sidewalk permit to -

- 1) place a small stand, 1½ ft. in width and 3 ft. in length at the edge of its leasehold on the sidewalk.
- 2) and or that the petitioner be permitted to have a sales person at the edge of its leasehold on the sidewalk.

Petitioner further states that it makes the above prayers with full knowledge and approval of the landlord at 40 Brattle Street.
