AIRCALL NORTHEAST, INC./RAM COMMUNICATIONS OF MASS.

Aircall Northeast, Inc. ("Aircall") and RAM Communications of Mass., Inc. ("RAM") have filed with the Department for approval of the transfer of Aircall's certificate of public convenience and necessity for Station KCA668 in Amesbury, Massachusetts that provides paging services in Northeastern Massachusetts and Southeastern New Hampshire area from Aircall to RAM. Aircall and RAM have entered into an asset purchase agreement whereby RAM will purchase the property and assets of Aircall, including Station KCA668.

The license for Station KCA668 was previously part of an asset purchase agreement between Arch Communications Group, Inc. and Aircall in docket D.P.U. 89-75. However, the above-referenced assignment was apparently not consummated by the parties.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed transfer must be made in writing and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before January 14, 1991.

The petitioner is required to give notice of request by publication hereof once, no later than January 2, 1991 in the Boston Globe and the Lawrence Eagle-Tribune, and to serve a copy hereof no later than January 2, 1990 to the parties on the attached list.
