- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that Firefighter John M. Domings has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department, and
- WHEREAS:** Firefighter Domings was first appointed to the department while serving in the United States Armed Forces on February 21, 1943 and actually began active fire service on March 30, 1947 when he was assigned to Engine Company 8, and
- WHEREAS:** He remained in that assignment until July 29, 1949 when he was transferred to Engine Company 1 where he remained for 21 years when he was transferred to Engine Company 3, remaining there until December 5, 1976 when he was transferred to Fire Headquarters, an assignment he held until he retired on July 10, 1977, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Firefighter John M. Domings for his dedication to duty for a total of 34 years and to further extend to him our best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.
