WHEREAS: Abraham Fishman first came to this country in 1906 and established a fur business which he operated until a few years ago, always associating himself with many philanthropic groups in Cambridge and Somerville; and

WHEREAS: In 1958, Mr. Fishman was honored jointly by the Cambridge Jewish Community Center and the Ladies Auxiliary of the Cambridge and Somerville Hebrew School from whom he received the first Annual Community Service Award and a plaque in appreciation of his many years of devoted and selfless labors for the sole purpose of keeping alive the Jewish culture; and

WHEREAS: Abraham Fishman had been the Honorary President of Temple Beth Shalom; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to the family of Abraham Fishman; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Fishman's family.
