- ORDERED: That the Deputy City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Acting Police Chief to take the appropriate steps to review the telephone tape recording regarding a conversation between a resident of Webster Avenue and an employee at the police station, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Deputy City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Acting Police Chief to assign someone to obtain, in a confidential manner, any and all information from the residents of the Webster Avenue/Hampshire Street area relative to the troublesome youth which congregate in this area, as well as to place special attention in this area by the sector cars route patrol and park patrol cars, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Deputy City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct Police Chief Leo Davenport to attend the next meeting of this City Council scheduled for Monday, October 6, 1980 in order to discuss this and other neighborhood problems and to request the leadership of the Patrolman's Association as well, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Deputy City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council as soon as possible on the action taken by him pursuant to this order.
