In Board of Aldermen, Jan. 10. 1888.

Ordered,

That the Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges, be authorized to purchase from time to time during the year, Hay, Grain and other supplies, necessary for the use of the Street department, and also to contract for such quantities of ^{Field} Stone, Gravel and other materials, as may be required for the usual and ordinary operations of said department.

Also, that said committee be authorized to empower the Superintendent of Streets to employ such labor as may be required to carry on the work of the Street department during the current year.

Contracts made under the foregoing provisions, to be without advertising for proposals therefor.

Expenses incurred by authority of this order, to be charged to the proper appropriations.
