Whereas, it would be a fitting addition to have such a symbol at each such veteran's grave.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Marsh Post No. 442 of the American Legion of the City of Cambridge at a meeting assembled on January 21, 1958, respectfully requests that the necessary action be taken by the City of Cambridge whereby a cross or a Star of David be placed on the grave of each such veteran and,

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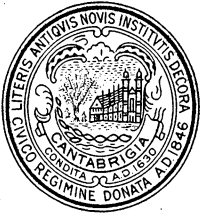
