Disbursement of \$100,000 Grant Fund

In response to City Council Order #20 of January 7, 1985 regarding establishment of an Advisory Committee, the Community Development Department has set up a committee to advise staff on the expenditure of a \$100,000 Grant Fund made available by the Marcus Organization. The Committee is composed of four Cambridge residents; two are members of the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee. Committee members are Nick Geraigery, Joe Riley, Barbara Shaw, and Chris Connaire (Arts Council).

The Committee met on Wednesday, January 16. (Joe Riley was unable to attend.) After reviewing the fifteen proposals received from Webb Building artists, the Committee made decisions on the award of grants based on eligibility and priorities agreed upon by the artists themselves. The artists have been notified of the Committee's decisions and will be receiving checks from the Marcus Organization in the near future. The full amount of the Grant Fund was disbursed with a small portion set aside for artists who need to submit final cost estimates. The Committee can be reconvened should the set-asides not be used and therefore be available for other artists.

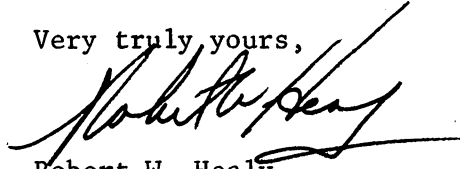
