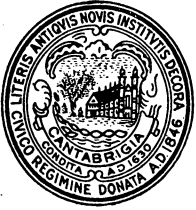

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$561.16 to reimburse James P. Cassidy, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.

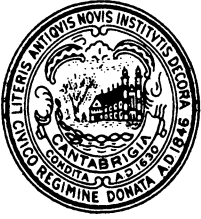
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against James P. Cassidy in which there was a judgment of \$561.16.


To the Honorable, the City Council,
