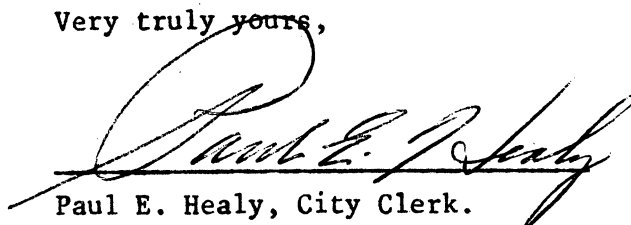
Dear Ms. Moretti:

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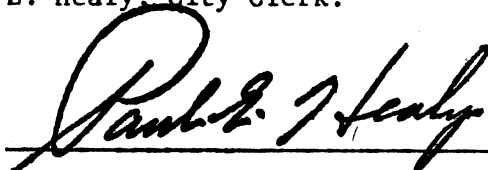
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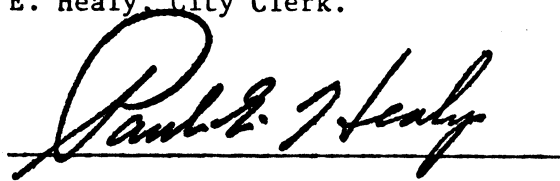

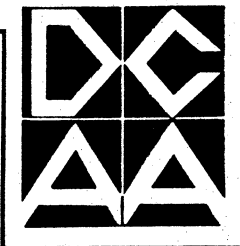

On Saturday, September 28th from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. The Averof will come alive with the spirit of ancient Greece and the Middle East - with The First Annual Averof Greek and Middle Eastern Fair to benefit The Massachusetts Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children. Raymond and John Bandar, owners of the Averof, have pledged to donate proceeds from the Fair to the MSPCC. During a special ceremony at the close of the Fair, Bill Walker, Regional Director of the MSPCC, will accept the donation.

Much effort and enthusiasm has been shown by The Averof, the MSPCC, and fair participants, including The Mykonos of Cambridge, toward making this event well attended and successful. All are committed to raising as much money for the MSPCC as possible!

Publicity for the Fair will include calendar listings in all Boston and Suburban publications. Public service announcements are scheduled to be aired on radio and TV. And flyers will be posted in designated public areas.

The day's events will include the following indoor and outdoor festivities (contained within The Averof and its surrounding property.)

- Magnificent foods prepared by The Averof - served in the restaurant and at the outdoor cafe. The Averof "Take-out Shoppe" will offer delicious specialties to bring home.

- Live music and Dancing - traditional Greek Folk Dancing and Belly Dancing demonstrated in the Averof Restaurant.
- Arts and Handicrafts exhibits and sale - including imported clothing from The Mykonos of Cambridge.
- "Kiddie Rides" a small "moonwalk" and "ferris Wheel" will be set-up in The Averof parking lot for children to enjoy. Rides are provided by Sam Pino, the vendor who for years has managed kiddie rides at the North End Festivals and recently at "Walt Disney World Day" in Government Center. Rides will be supervised by qualified, experienced personnel. The rides are insured by the company that is providing them for the Fair.
- Petting Zoo - a small petting zoo will be set up in The Averof's parking lot including baby sheep, goats, llama and camel. They will be contained in a small pen and managed by qualified personnel from Benson's Animal Farm.
