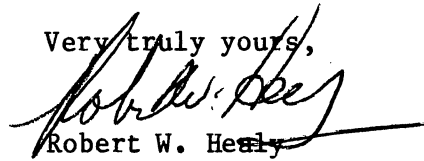

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$8,300.00 from the Library Salary & Wages Account to the Library Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to provide funds for the items mentioned below.

1. In 1986/87, the ornamental plaster was restored at the Cardinal O'Connell Branch, including the painting of walls and ceilings.
2. In 1986/87, the Valente Library was completely restored - new exterior brick and closure of windows and interior painting.
3. In 1988, the North Cambridge Branch Library was totally painted by the Department of Public Works.
4. In 1988/89, new adult furniture (tables, chairs, lounge furniture et al), including some children's furniture was purchased for these three branch libraries. A grant-in-aid program from the State Board of Library Commissioners made this possible.
