The Cambridge Redevelopment Authority will hold a public meeting at the Kennedy School Auditorium, 158 Spring Street, at 7:30 P.M. on Thursday, November 6, to identify community concerns respecting the potential environmental impact of proposed development for the Kendall Square Project Area.

The Authority has executed a contract with the firm of Metcalf & Eddy, Inc. for consultant services in connection with the preparation of an Environmental Impact Study and has directed the firm to prepare an inventory of community concerns for potential impacts of proposed Kendall Square development.

The information gathered at the public meeting will be used by the consultant to help formulate a work program to carry out the Environmental Impact Study.

Questionnaires, urging citizen participation in providing Metcalf & Eddy, Inc. with information on individual concerns about environmental matters, have been widely distributed to residences and



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businesses in the neighborhoods surrounding the Kendall Square area, and have been sent to interested groups and residents throughout the City.

The concerns listed in the questionnaire range from traffic congestion to employment opportunities, and also include noise, air quality, population changes, water pollution, water supply, sewer system capacity, effect of development on nearby property values, effect of development on rental levels, effect of development on property taxes, and school capacities.

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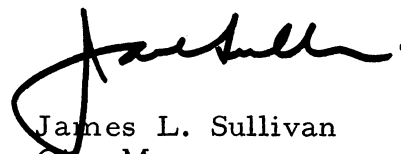
