To the Honorable, the City Council;

In response to Awaiting Report #47 of May 21, 1990 regarding the Rev. Thomas Williams (Sleeper) Park, please be advised that the Department of Public Works is in the process of completing work on the park.

The water fountain has been repaired, and the fence and the walkways will be completed shortly. The lawn will be seeded as needed. The problem with the gravel is more difficult. Although the park is swept often, the design of the park makes it difficult to keep the gravel off the basketball courts. Children playing in the sand naturally throw it around and much of it lands on the basketball court. The slide, for example, is pointed towards the basketball courts and constant use pushes the sand onto the courts. We are in the process of evaluating the design.
