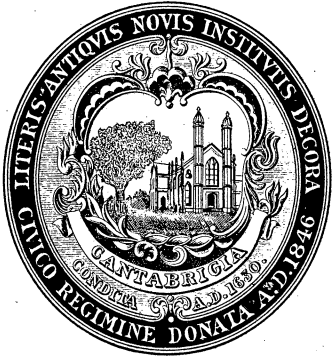

City of Cambridge:-

My attention has been called to conditions at the old Corlett School building on Holworthy street. This building is in a dilapidated condition and is a menace to the neighborhood. Because of acts of vandalism it is a great nuisance and disturbance to the people in the vicinity, as well as a fire hazard.

This building was abandoned by the School Committee for school purposes in the month of December, 1915.

I respectfully recommend that it be disposed of by sale. I also recommend for your consideration the advisability of authorizing the sale of the land upon which this building is situated, which contains 10,000. sq. ft..
