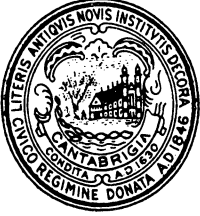


NOTICE TO ALL TEMPORARY INHABITANTS
OF THE
CITY OF CAMBRIDGE

The Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts provide that no motor vehicle or trailer owned by a nonresident may be operated in this Commonwealth for more than thirty (30) days in the aggregate in any one year unless such vehicle is registered in this Commonwealth or covered by liability insurance at least to the amount required of such vehicles which are registered in this Commonwealth.

Every nonresident enrolled as a student in this Commonwealth who operates a motor vehicle, which is not registered in this Commonwealth, for more than thirty (30) days in the aggregate during any twelve (12) month period beginning on September first, shall on or before the thirtieth (30th) day file a statement with the police department of the city wherein the school or college is located.

Strict penalties are provided for failure to comply with the law.

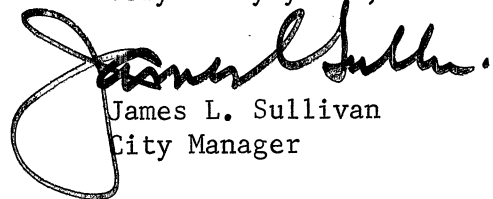
