RESOLVED: That the owner of the property, the City Manager, the Commissioner of the Building Department, Community Development and all other relevant agencies be invited to attend a hearing at the Cambridge City Council on December 7, 1992 for a public hearing to discuss the future of this property and that prior to this hearing, the City Manager give the Council a full written report as to the status of the property including reports from the various agencies involved.
