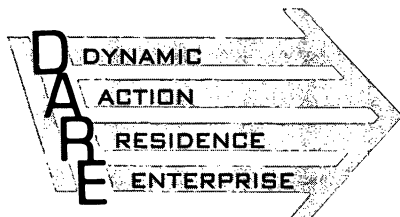

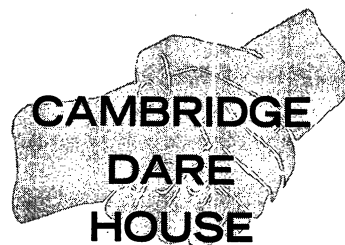

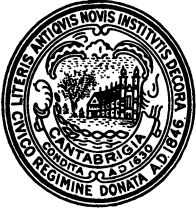
Dear Mr. Cronin:
